Manikaji Mekar Village School Bali, Indonesia



Manikaji community comprises over 300 families scattered over the steep and arid slopes of Mount Abang in East Bali, most living an average 5 miles walk from the nearest government school. EBPP's Manikaji Mekar Community "Learning and Development Centre" (school) started in January 2001 and provides the only accessible education facility for almost 90 children for all levels from elementary to senior high school. The school building is now in very poor condition with leaking roof, no ceiling, most windows and doors off their hinges and at the end of each day, children must store all chairs and materials in the library, the only lockable room. The ODFL funding will enable complete renovation of Manikaji School, including ceilings, new doors and windows, repairing walls and floors, floor tiles and painting inside and out. All work will be done by the community and children, as they "own" the centre, guided by EBPP infrastructure team. The children and community are very excited about improving their learning centre, providing their children with a safer and brighter learning environment.
